While the Malaysian Women team might have encountered challenges from more experienced teams, their presence in this championship marked a positive step in introducing Malaysia to the International Kho Kho Sports Arena.

Every match and experience gained in this championship will serve as the foundation for the development of the Malaysian Kho Kho team in the future. The experience of competing against the best teams in Asia will assist the Malaysian women's team in improving their game and honing their skills in preparation for high-profile events such as the **Proposed International Kho Kho Test Match 2023 to be held in Melaka from 12<sup>th.</sup> To 15<sup>th.</sup> Oct. 2023.**


